PLEASE BE PATIENT with your new pet and remember that he/she is likely scared, lonely, and missing his old family. It is imperative that you take every opportunity you can to show him/her kindness, gentleness, and love to ease the transition. It can take days or even weeks for your new family member to warm up to you.

Home visit: You agree to allow us to visit your home by appointment as part of our application process.

Veterinarian check: You agree to allow us to contact your vet either in person or on the phone to verify the past medical care of any and all of your previous animals.

Reference check: You agree to allow us to contact your references either in person or on the phone to interview them as to your dog ownership potential.

Microchip information: Your new dog is microchipped and the chip is and will remain registered to Houston Street Dogs. Your contact info will be listed as an alternate contact. You agree to not change the microchip contact information except to provide us with updated contact information if you change your address (physical or email) and/or phone numbers.

Please note that the Houston Street Dogs adoption fee is \$200. This fee is non-refundable under all circumstances. This covers:

Rabies vaccination
DHPPL vaccination
Spay/neuter surgery
Deworming
Microchip
Ear cleaning/nail trim

Your new pet should still see your veterinarian when you get him/her home. Many veterinarians like to do fecal and blood tests on new animals to get baseline values. Your pet must visit a veterinarian within two weeks of his adoption date or he/she will be reclaimed by Houston Street Dogs.
